



TIM BAUER

Originally from Kansas, Tim Bauer, started his career in teaching internationally in Asia, but decided to follow a personal dream and came to Vancouver to study illustration. He is the illustrator and creator behind Woahman Comics, and some of his influences and inspirations come from comic books, old 80's cartoons, Hong Kong action theatre, fashion illustration, Sci-fi movies, and drag queens. In 2017 and 2018 Tim was short-listed for the Broken Pencil Zine awards. He has also been the featured artist for SADmag in August of 2019. He is currently an artist in residence at a local elementary school where he creates art projects with the students.

He is also a fan of people that have the courage to blur gender in their fashion and artwork, which has inspired him to create "campy" comics. In most of Tim's work he has been experimenting with interactive elements including anaglyph 3d prints of his comics (aka 3d comics –the ones with the red and blue lenses). Since 2015, Tim has been making a new zines that gives off a vintage, psychedelic, campy, and queer tone. Among other things, he is recently finished a 52 page comic for a Korean haunted tour company called "The Dark Side of Seoul" that features Korean ghost tales in April 2020.
